RULES AND REGULATIONS

NHSRA RULES will be utilized by FJR committee and JUDGES will make the final determination.

Admission: FREE admission

1. All contestants shall comply with the rules. Any unsportsman like conduct will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**.
2. As of January 1, 2019 you must be no older than 18 years of age. New Contestants must provide proof of age with entry (copy of birth certificate).
3. No entry form will be accepted unless **signed by Parent or Guardian**.
4. Contestant numbers must be worn on back at all times or **DISQUALIFICATION** will result. (Pick up at time of check in.)
5. **ALL CONTESTANTS MUST WEAR WESTERN ATTIRE.** (western boots, western trousers, western hat, long sleeve wrist length shirt with collar & cuffs)
6. **\$5 FINE** for losing hat during competition in the arena.
7. Drug or alcohol use by a Contestant will result in automatic **DISQUALIFICATION**. NO alcoholic beverages in the arena (adults).
8. Contestant's name will be called 3 times, if not present on third call, you are **DISQUALIFIED & TURNOUT** in that event. **No refunds or substitutes for TURNOUTS.** (Medical releases will be at the discretion of the Arena Director and Committee.)
9. Pee Wee event contestants will be disqualified if they don't have stirrups that fit them (i.e. parent's saddles) due to safety concerns. They must have control of their horses. If the arena director thinks the saddle or a horse pose a safety issue the pee-wee contestant may be unable to participate in the mounted events.

GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

- Contestants must **ONLY** address all questions or problems to the Arena Director. Parent or other interested person who gets involved with the event director, judges, or other rodeo official, runs the risk of having the person whom they are trying to assist **DISQUALIFIED**.
- No one is allowed in the arena unless an official of the rodeo or granted by the Arena Director.

EVENT RULES

- **30 SECOND TIME LIMIT FOR ALL EVENTS!!**

STEER DAUBING** If you enter Steer Daubing you **CANNOT** enter any roping events. Horse **MUST** be backed in the box prior to calling for your steer.

TEAM ROPING •3 Loops •**CONFIRM** with **PARTNER**. Both entries must be received. You're responsible to find your partner.

ADULT TR PARTNER **WIN CASH ONLY).** Go 1x only.

DUMMY ROPING 90 second time limit for each roper. Official will count legal head catches. Top 5 ropers with greatest number of catches return for short-go. **SHORT-GO:** Each will rope again for 90 seconds to determine winner.

HIDE RACE PULLER Hide Race Puller **MUST** be over 14 yrs. old. You're responsible to find your partner. Go 1x only. **WIN CASH ONLY).**

CALF/STEER RIDING Must ride 6 seconds to get a score.

CALF/STEER/BULLRIDING **PROTECTIVE VEST IS MANDATORY!!** If NO qualified ride, the buckle will go to longest time and NO points or money will be given.

PEEWEE If your horse is on a lead line – you will place behind the peewees that run with no assistance.
