PARADE RULES

**** Please Honor the Most Recent COVID Protocols ****

1. **Parade starts at 11:00 a.m. SHARP!** Units not in position by 9:30 a.m. will be placed at the end of the parade.
2. All entries to be judged must be in their spaces by 9:00 a.m.
3. Thirty feet of spacing between all units.
4. If you plan on dispensing gifts or candy - it must be done by **persons walking near your float.** It is against the law to throw objects from a parade unit (float or vehicle).
5. Entries must have full control of animals or vehicles at all times. Displays of vehicular speed will be cause for **IMMEDIATE** dismissal from the parade.
6. Units with music or unusual sounds must be indicated on the entry form.
7. No entry may enter the parade more than once for competition regardless of change in name or appearance.
8. Any person or group may enter the parade subject to space limitations. Failure to comply with rules may result in penalty and/or disqualification.
9. The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry not considered to be safe in the parade.
10. Prizes will be given out prior to the parade.
11. Your number and street location will be given out by **phone call** on the Wednesday or Thursday prior to the parade.
12. **NO** alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the parade route.
13. Forward motion must be maintained at ALL Times. Units will be disqualified for any delays.
14. Parade route is Main Street, down Fortuna Boulevard to Newburg Road.
